Elementary Report - Jon Wennstrom

Superintendent's Report – Andrea Oquist

- Federal funding review with Alison Smith. District will be sending a survey to families to receive feedback on how they are interested in ESSER III funds (Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund) best be spent. District looking for feedback about the survey from Council to help create an ideal survey for families that is easy to complete and understand. They are also required to receive stakeholder feedback as part of the process of receiving the funds.
- These funds are term limited. They must be used by 9/2023. The funds must be used for things tied to learning loss or any other impacts resulting from COVID-19.
- The survey will be sent to parents, secondary students, staff, and community members.
- The district's application for these funds currently has 19 line items.

Suggestions from Council members for the survey:

- Add a due date and the amount of time needed to complete the survey
- Change "class size reduction" wording to "maintain smaller class sizes"
- Add an "I don't know" option or "Unsure"

- Mention that this survey is for broad spectrum feedback and that it will be followed up with a more specific survey
- Make sure to list that the funds have to be used by 9/2023
- Add a question about family social/emotional support, parent engagement, and other related resources
- Make the explanation of the survey more simple and less wordy
- Don't send it on a Friday. Maybe a Sunday?
- Send it out a 2nd time as a last chance opportunity to complete it
