Superintendent Report – Dan W. for Andrea O.

- Council's IEP Binder Event materials will be funded by the district (\$6500.00). The district felt that this was something they wanted to personally fund. Dr. Tairaiol will be Andrea M.'s main contact for this. Big thank you to LPS for funding this!

Secondary Report - Dan W.

- Graduation ceremonies last weekend. Working on ways to get better cooperation from parents regarding noise during ceremonies.
- Final Assessments for Middle schools on half days 6/16 6/17, for high schools on half days 6/15 6/17.
- Some administration changes: Ms. Kristen Quesada for principal at CHS, Mr. Roger Opsommer for Holmes principal.
- Interviews for new Asst. Principals for SHS and CHS wrapped up today. Interviews for new Asst. Principal at Emerson will be tomorrow.
- Anticipate that the free breakfast/lunch program will not be continued next year. Encourage families to fill out the reduced/free lunch form if they need it.
- Transportation needs announcement will go out next week.
- Enrollment confirmation will go out on Aug 1st (emergency contact info, etc.). Please encourage units to spread the word when it goes out.
- Dan thanked Council for continued partnership throughout the years. Dan retiring after 26 years in LPS. Council presented Dan with a gift basket that included etched glasses made by the Ausome Designs students from the Western Wayne Skill Center.

Elementary Report – Danielle D. for Jon Wennstrom

- Admin changes for Elementary: Jon Wennstrom as Riley's new principal, Jen Wilson as Buchanan's new principal, Lora Boka as a student services coordinator for LPS, Kristyn Cousino as Webster's new principal, Mike Daraskavich as Hoover's new principal, and Julie Linn as Randolph's new principal.
- Kindergarten round-up this week at all elementary buildings.
- Summer Learning in L Town camps information flyer has gone out to families. Camps in each triad for $2^{nd}-8^{th}$ and one week of camp (Aug $8^{th}-11^{th}$) for incoming and current kindergarten students. Family Fridays will be happening again with information coming soon. Tutoring will also be offered in person with no virtual option. Andrea M. asked what supports will be available at

- the camps for children with IEP's and 504's. Danielle D. stated there will be special education teachers, paras, social workers, and psychologists on staff at the camps.
- Renovations this summer at Kennedy, Coolidge, Randolph, Cooper, Emerson.
- Project Lead the Way Pilot (a 5th special for K-4) is stem, project-based learning that will be at Hayes, Hoover, and Randolph. 1 teacher at each of these buildings for this.
- Kindergarten Grouping Pilot will be at Kennedy, Roosevelt, and Cleveland. This entails mixing groups of K students for the 1st week of school where each student will meet all the teachers and after properly assessing needs, they will be placed in their classrooms the 2nd week of school.

NEW BUSINESS

Bylaws Update – Nikki Watson

- Presented updated bylaws for Council to be in accordance with the approved amendments to MI PTA bylaws last August. Biggest change is the \$40 dues to MI PTA is now due December 1st instead of June 1st.
- Livonia PTSA Bylaws are now in compliance with the latest Council bylaws template released by MI PTA.

ELVS/Math APS Update – Chris C.

- ELVS received 155 signups. Currently have 50 volunteers right now. Held a contest at the 3 high schools to get more volunteers to sign up. Winner got a Barnes & Noble gift card for their school library.
- Currently in the process of assignments. It will run July 27th August 19th.
- Kellie D. stated some Robotics students are willing to be alternate volunteers if needed.
