The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Andrea M.

Approval of the September 20, 23 meeting minutes motioned by Nicole D., 2nd by Keadin P., unanimously approved.

Superintendent Report – Phil F.

- This week LPS announced the Elementary Teacher of the Year Amy Chapman-Pinta EST at Grant Elementary, Secondary Teacher of the Year – Terri Bennett Math Teacher at Franklin High School, and Support Staff of the Year – Krystal Reid Para Pro at Garfield Community School. Phil read the award description for each of them. They were all surprised by their school staff and will be recognized at the next school board meeting, the LPTSAC Founders Day Celebration and the Livonia/Westland Chamber dinner.
- The LPS Education Foundation presented 32 grants to LPS staff totaling \$50,005.
- SHS, Holmes, Hayes, Hoover and Roosevelt will get renovations next summer. There will also be renovations to SHS, CHS, and FHS pool rooms.

Elementary Report – Jon W.

- Congrats to Amy Chapman-Pinta, Elementary Teacher of the Year.
- Fall fundraising via the PTAs at the elementary schools has gone well. These funds are used for all kinds of great projects for elementary students.
- K-6 admin and all staff used PD days to be trained by Connie Hamilton; a content area leader who has a book called Hacking Questions.
- PLTW shipments have arrived and teachers are very excited to continue this work with students.
- The BOE held their last study session at Riley. The BOE is traveling to different schools for their meetings to see all the renovated spaces. The Riley staff did a great job presenting things that are happening at Riley.

<u>Secondary Report</u> – Shanan W.

- The first combined middle school activity night went well. There were over 900 students. The next one will be in February at Emerson.
- The middle school principals are meeting to look at bullying and harassment in the schools. It is a problem every year and they are looking for preemptive solutions.
- All levels finished the first rounds of CSA's. Teachers used their PD day to look through the data to proceed for the next semester.
- The staff was also trained in CIRT, Critical Incident Response Training. It is general information about how to respond to safety issues within the building. This was part of the safety inspection that the district had in the spring.

- Bill Shank, who worked for the CIA, presented to all 7th-grade students on internet safety. He gave them information about how to keep themselves safe while chatting with people online.
- The district has also just begun working towards universal accommodations and what that means for all children in the district.
- Frost is using their mascot time for targeted interventions so that class time is not interrupted.

<u>Guest Speaker</u> – James McConnell from the Livonia Historical Society.

- LHS is seeking donations so that all Livonia 2nd graders will have the opportunity to attend the 1 room schoolhouse at Greenmead. They attend class in the Newburgh School building during the visit and then play games outside.
- They will also be seeking PTA support for this program for spring 2025.
- Jen Corey from LPS is working on equal field trip experiences for all students and LHS has met with her. There is more information attached to the main copy of these minutes.
- For now, Council will share this information with the school PTA's and they can decide if they want to donate. Grant Elementary PTA already helps pay for this field trip for their 2nd graders.
