- Storm protocols were in place during today's storms. Buses are to go to the nearest LPS school and hold in place.
- Sub A Staffer assignments will be starting soon. There were 12 winners chosen and it raised about \$2000 for the foundation.
- M Step testing and SAT testing have started. PTA's have been celebrating students and helping them with little treats.

- Coolidge hosted the school board meeting. The school board has been having meetings throughout the district.
- ECC construction is coming along. The administration met with the playground people recently.
- Learning in L Town information will be coming out soon.
- A question was asked about the district's financial situation based on what is happening in Ann Arbor. Andrea O says LPS has planned ahead and has been very responsible with the fund balance knowing that enrollment will continue to decline because birth rates are declining.
 They are keeping services for mental health and the fund balance will still be around 17%, within the limits of the MOSB.
- Mandy G. met with the MI PTA and they are preparing a resolution to have a librarian in every school in Michigan.
